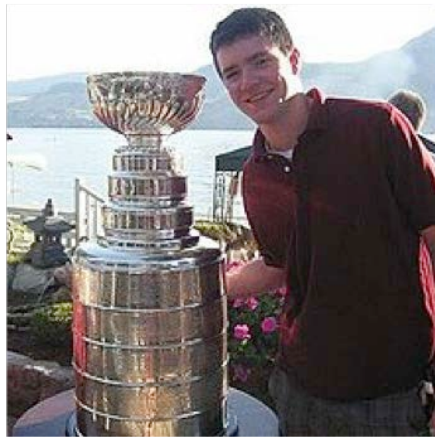
You Can Play works to ensure safety and inclusion for all who participate in sports, including LGBTQ athletes, coaches and fans.
