Help move ENDA forward!

The fully inclusive Employment Non-Discrimination Act - which would protect lesbian, gay bisexual and transgender Americans from workplace discrimination - continues to face delays despite growing support.

The decision on whether ENDA will move forward or stall rests with the leadership of the United States House of Representatives. The time is now for us to tell Speaker of the House Nancy Pelosi and our House Representatives that they must protect all Americans from discrimination by moving ENDA forward immediately. It is no longer acceptable to wait.

Speak up by contacting Speaker Pelosi's office and requesting that ENDA move now. Contact your federal lawmakers, asking that she or he support ENDA and call on them to take action on the bill immediately.
